HB20-1160 Drug Price Transparency Insurance Premium Reductions

Requires disclosure of proprietary information

HB20-1162 Prohibit Food Establishments' Use Of Polystyrene  
Bans Styrofoam etc

HB20-1163 Management Of Single-use Products

The bill prohibits stores and retail food establishments, on and after July 1, 2021, from providing single-use plastic carryout bags, single-use plastic stirrers, single-use plastic straws, and expanded polystyrene food service products (collectively "single-use products") to customers at the point of sale. Charge at least \$.10 per paper bag

Provide employee info on political cost of union dues

SB20-121 Manage Gray Wolves In Colorado

Wolves already exist in Northern CO

Requires assessment of cost of laws and regulations to businesses
